Teen and Young Adults Transitional Housing (Ages 18-24)	\$7,000,000
• Individual Apartments (12)	\$500,000 ea.
• Living Rooms (12)	\$100,000 ea.
• Kitchens (12)	\$75,000 ea.
• Bedrooms (24)	\$50,000 ea.
Youth Drop-In Center (Ages 12-24)	\$1,000,000
• Training & Education Room Life Skills classes, access to technology, workspaces, tutoring, etc.	\$500,000
• Recreation Room Extracurricular activities that focus on physical, emotional, and mental well-being	\$350,000
• Kitchenette & Laundry Room Food preparation, dining area, laundry amenities	\$250,000
• Safe Place for Trafficked Youth Includes access to a private shower, new clothes, food, and other resources	\$200,000
• Family/Childcare Room Young parents can develop their skills and spend time with their children in a safe place, as well as receive childcare while attending classes	\$150,000
• Collaboration Room Where staff and volunteers will meet with youth to assess needs and provide mentoring, support, and resources	\$150,000
• Counseling Rooms (2)	\$100,000 ea.
• Urgent Needs Closet Includes clothes, essential items, hygiene products, etc.	\$100,000
• Food Pantry Immediate grocery needs met for children and families	\$100,000
