

CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN CRISIS



At 15, Jacob found himself struggling with his mental health, social anxiety, and a negative self-image linked to his weight.

After being removed from his mother's care, Jacob who now lives with his grandmother, Ms. Clara, faced trouble at school with chronic absences and failing grades. Isolated and withdrawn, he spent most of his time in his room, and rarely communicating with others.

Jacob was referred to Olive Crest for comprehensive mental health support. His care team worked closely with him and his grandmother to offer therapeutic assistance and educational resources. With consistent support and as his team earned his trust, Jacob's recovery began as he started to engage and his school performance improved.

Soon, Jacob started attending the gym, boosting his confidence and reshaping his self-image. The once reclusive teenager began to see himself and his surroundings more optimistically. His newfound confidence and improved outlook led him to pursue an interest in journalism. With guidance and preparation, Jacob secured a position to write stories about his community, a role that he continues to excel in and enjoy.

Today, Jacob is on track to graduate from high school and has plans to study law at a four-year university. The progress Jacob has made is more than academic; it is also deeply personal. Jacob and Ms. Clara communicate effectively and support each other as they navigate daily challenges.





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Kiana, a single mother with two young children, sought refuge from a domestic violence situation. With most of her family in another country, Kiana struggled to adjust to her new life as a single parent to Kendra and Kendrick.

Trusting others was difficult for her, and she was initially reluctant to accept help. Fortunately, Kiana and her children frequently attended Olive Crest community events and staff were able to slowly build familiarity and trust with the trio.

Over time, and with a great deal of encouragement, Kiana decided to participate in our hosting program. Reflecting on her first experience, she shared, "As I begin to step out of the box and learn, I'm noticing that there are people out there that want to help. The hosts were so helpful [with Kendrick] this weekend. I got to work extra hours and I had one-on-one mommy and me time with Kendra. I haven't had that with her since she was born. This weekend went great. I really appreciate the host family because this is not a walk in the park."

Kiana's initial standoffishness gradually melted away. She learned to accept help, realizing she didn't have to navigate this journey alone. Working through her past traumas, including her experiences in the child welfare system, Kiana is determined to provide a better life for her children. Her resilience and commitment to self-improvement are inspiring, and she is focused on being the best mom she can be, mentally and physically.

Jason (22) has faced significant challenges during his young life, including battling mental illness, the stress of caring for his younger siblings, and an unstable home life that led to addiction and crime as coping mechanisms.

However, when given the opportunity, Jason fully embraced support from Olive Crest to turn his life around. He attended every appointment diligently and even sought inpatient treatment for his marijuana addiction. Jason continues to remain sober, proud of his resilience and commitment. He shared during a recent meeting, "You know what surprises me most about sobriety? I thought it would be boring, but it's not. I feel like I'm finally living."

Jason's transformation goes beyond his sobriety. He recently discovered he will soon be a father to a baby boy. Fueled with new purpose, Jason secured employment to provide for his growing family, took driver's education classes, and is working towards obtaining his license. He regularly attends Independent Living Skills classes that offer support, connection, training, and community for young adults to prosper.

Jason's journey is a testament to the power of resilience and the impact of support. His determination to create a better future for himself and his family is truly inspiring.



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Brooke (12) had grown accustomed to feeling like she didn't quite fit in anywhere. Before her placement with an Olive Crest family, she struggled to make sense of her world. Her days were marked by frequent tantrums and outbursts in class, and her teachers often struggled to keep her focused. At home, similar behaviors continued, with Brooke often feeling overwhelmed by expectations and responsibilities. It was evident that Brooke had behavior difficulties and mental health needs. Thankfully, there was an Olive Crest family equipped and ready to take her in with loving arms.

With her new family's guidance and love, Brooke has flourished. They discovered that positive reinforcement helped Brooke, making her feel seen and heard in ways she never had before. Her behavior improved at school, and she continues to make progress. They encourage her creativity, supporting her artistic pursuits like painting and crocheting. The family has even brought her along on their family vacations—including trips to the beach and out-of-state.

Due to the loving care, attention, and patience that she has received, Brooke no longer feels stressed and overwhelmed. In fact, she now talks about her future with optimism and confidence. With Olive Crest's ongoing support, Brooke is no longer just surviving - she's flourishing, and her future looks brighter than ever.




